Herbicides used: Glyphosate, Platoon, copper sulfate, Cutrine, Schooner

Weather Conditions: Sunny, low winds, weather is good for treating lakes.

Special Notes: The cyanobacteria in Lake 11 has returned, but is not as heavy.

Lake Y-2: Rated: 8

- Spotty grasses around perimeter, south side of lake.
- Moderate debris blown into NE cove.



Treatment: I launched the airboat and treated grasses in the south side and hand raked debris in the NE cove.

Recommendations: None.

Lake 11: **Rated: 5**

- Moderate floating cyanobacteria in the NE corner.
- Minor debris around perimeter.



Treatment: Inspection only, this type of weed dissipates as it warms.

Recommendations: I will monitor this lake closely.

Lake N: **Rated: 8**

- Minor algae growing on dying bacopa.



Treatment: I hand raked the dying bacopa and treated the remaining algae.

Recommendations: None.

Lake JJ: Rated: 9

- Minor shoreline grasses around perimeter.



Treatment: I will treat when the grasses become heavier.

Recommendations: None.

Lake KK: Rated: 8

- Spotty grasses around perimeter.
- Small gator in the pond.



Treatment: I will treat grasses next time.

Recommendations: Have gator removed.

Lake LL: Rated: 8

- Moderate pennywort around perimeter.
- Six foot gator in the pond.



Treatment: I treated the pennywort by backpack.

Recommendations: Remove gator.

Lake X-1: Rated: 10

- Torpedo grass out of the water at water's edge.



Treatment: I cleaned the fish barrier.

Recommendations: Trim torpedo grass down to water's edge.

Lake 4: Rated: 10

- Heavy overgrowth of terrestrial plants on undeveloped side.



Treatment: Inspection only.

Recommendations: None.

Lake 5: Rated: 9

- Minor shoreline grasses around perimeter.



Treatment: I will treat if grasses become heavier.

Recommendations: None.

Lake V-2: **Rated: 10**

- All weeds under control.
- Grass carp are working.



Treatment: Inspection only, lake looks great.

Recommendations: Be on the lookout for gators.

Lake 6: **Rated: 6**

- Heavy floating algae growing on dying submersed weeds.



Treatment: I launched the airboat and treated the algae.

Recommendations: I may need more grass carp.

Lake 7: Rated: 10

- Minor torpedo grass and pennywort along the edge.



Treatment: I treated the grasses by backpack. Grass carp are doing a great job.

Recommendations: Be on the lookout for gators.

Lake 9: Rated: 4

- Heavy duckweed covering most of the pond.
- Moderate grasses along the edge.



Treatment: I treated by backpack only. I needed to launch the boat, but the access is very wet and soft. Backing in the boat would have caused deep ruts so I will check next week.

Recommendations: There is another way into the lake, but I will need permission when the homeowner is home.

Lake 8: Rated: 9

- Minor pennywort along the edge.



Treatment: I treated the pennywort by backpack.

Recommendations: None.

Lake 3: Rated: 7

- Heavy red Ludwigia along the edge.
- Minor grasses along the edge.



Treatment: Inspection only, I will treat next time.

Recommendations: Be on the lookout for gators.
