The Marshall Creek Community Development District ("MCCDD") and Sweetwater Creek Community Development District ("SCCDD") rules allow for residents to "register" their caregiver for a maximum time of 2 weeks. Caregivers are defined as someone caring for a child or special needs adult resident. Caregivers may only have access to the Marshall Creek CDD family pool, however special needs adult caregivers may have access to the fitness facility. The child or special needs adult must be present with his or her(s) amenity card. **Residents must pre-register their caregiver prior to admittance.** This usage will NOT apply to the 30 guest passes assigned per household per year, and/or to any additional passes purchased, including summer or daily passes, in accordance with MCCDD and SCCDD policies, rules and regulations.
