Special Notes: There has been a continuing outbreak of cyanobacteria on several of the lakes in Palencia including: **11**, **N**, **I-1**, **Y-2 and A**. I believe this outbreak is due to heavy rains during the dry season bringing in excess nutrients.

Lake Y-2: Rated: 6

- Cyanobacteria is heavy in extreme southern tip of the south lake.
- Float on Ultrasound has failed, and transducer has sunk to the bottom.
- Moderate cyanobacteria on the west side.



<u>Treatment</u>: I launched my boat and treated the cyanobacteria with 50 lbs. of alum and removed the sunken transducer to the ultrasound. I will replace the float next visit to the transducer and get it working again. Recommendations: None.

Lake I-1: Rated: 3

• An extremely heavy and thick layer of cyanobacteria was blown into the south side of lake.



<u>**Treatment:**</u> I launched my boat and applied 100 lbs of alum on the heavy cyanobacteria. <u>**Recommendations:**</u> None.

Lake N: Rated: 6

• Cyanobacteria has returned to the south end.



<u>Treatment:</u> I treated cyanobacteria with Green Clean (hydrogen peroxide). It was already turning brown before I left. <u>Recommendations:</u> None.
