### Lake N: Rated: 9

• Cyanobacteria has dissipated from last week.



<u>Treatment:</u> I picked up the trash. <u>Recommendations:</u> None.

• Extremely heavy, thick layer of cyanobacteria blown into the east side of this lake.



West – this is where it was before

East – this is where it is today

**Treatment:** I launched my boat and applied 100 lbs. of alum on the heavy cyanobacteria. **Recommendations:** None.
