Comments: The weather conditions today were cloudy, and rain was forecasted for the afternoon.

Lake 8: Rated: 9

- Moderate shoreline grasses on the undeveloped side of the pond.



Treatment: I launched the airboat (very difficult launch through a yard that is not an easement) and treated primarily the undeveloped side.

Recommendations: Keep an eye out for gators. Gators must be controlled for my biological program to work (grass carp).

Lake 6: **Rated: 7**

- Moderate pennywort, spikerush and southern water grass.
- Water level is normal.
- No gators observed.



Treatment: I launched the airboat and treated the weeds listed above. I also removed the bleed down fish barrier and photographed it for FWC permitting.

Recommendations: Keep a lookout for gators.

- Minor bacopa (submerged beneficial plant).
- Water level is low.
- No gators observed.
- Minor shoreline grasses.



Treatment: I fixed the fish barriers as directed by FWC for permitting purposes.

Recommendations: Keep a lookout for gators.
