<u>Comments:</u> Today's service was dedicated to the repair and upgrading of the fish barriers mentioned in the FWC inspection report.

#### **Lake 10: Rated: 10**

• There is minor pennywort around the perimeter.

- Minimal trash in the pond.
- The old PVC fish barrier is broken again.
- No alligators observed.





**Treatment:** I measured for a new fish barrier and a new bleed down barrier.

**Recommendations:** Keep an eye out for gators. Gators must be controlled for my biological program to work.

#### Lake 2: Rated: 8

- Spotty alligatorweed and bacopa.
- Bleed down barrier is missing.
- No gators observed.





<u>Treatment</u>: I treated the alligatorweed by backpack and I measured for the bleed down barrier replacement.

**Recommendations:** Keep a lookout for gators.

## **Lake CSP:** Rated: 9

- There is some floating debris and trash on the south side.
- No alligators observed.
- Bleed down barrier is missing.





<u>Treatment</u>: I removed the debris and trash and measured for the bleed down barrier. <u>Recommendations</u>: Keep an eye out for gators. Gators must be controlled for my biological program to work.

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#### Lake ER-1: Rated: 8

- Spotty submersed bacopa.
- Water level is low.
- No gators observed.





<u>Treatment</u>: I straightened the one bent barrier and measured for the missing bleed down barrier. <u>Recommendations</u>: Keep a lookout for gators

#### **Lake MUB-4:** Rated: 10

- There is minimal debris at the north end.
- No alligators observed.





**Treatment:** I measured for the missing bleed down barrier.

**Recommendations:** Keep an eye out for gators. Gators must be controlled for my biological program to work.

## **Lake A South:** Rated: 8

- Moderate submersed bacopa and some now exposed.
- Water level is low.









<u>Treatment</u>: I attached the bottom of the main barrier by tap cons and was able to remove and photograph the bleed down barrier.

**Recommendations:** Keep a lookout for gators.

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
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#### **Lake E:** Rated: 7

• Minor dead weeds around the perimeter and naiad is starting to grow in the shallows.

• No alligators observed.




<u>Treatment</u>: I attached the one side of the main barrier and found the bleed down barrier intact; however, I was unable to remove and photograph it.

**Recommendations:** Keep an eye out for gators. Gators must be controlled for my biological program to work.

## **Lake SV2A:** Rated: 10

- Minimal grasses.
- Water level is a little low.
- No gators observed.







<u>Treatment</u>: I attached the top of the main barrier and found the bleed down barrier intact but was unable to remove and photograph.

**Recommendations:** Keep a lookout for gators
