- No algae.
- Minor dead grasses along shoreline.



Treatment: None.

Recommendations: Please be advised that the driveway I have used to access the pond is the next door neighbors. The driveway with the pea gravel and French drains I have never driven on to access the pond.

**Lake 6: Rated: 6**

- Moderate algae, pennywort, spikerush and southern water grass around perimeter.

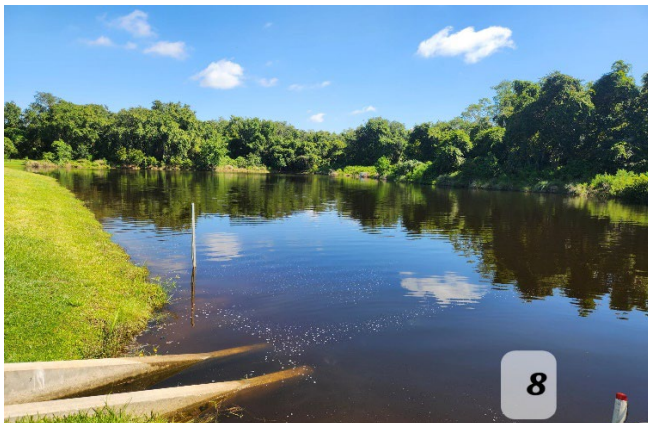


**Treatment:** I treated the weeds by airboat. This pond is being used for irrigation making treating the weeds very difficult.

**Recommendations:** I plan to stock grass carp in this pond this fall to better control the weeds.

**Lake 8: Rated: 10**

- Minimal shoreline grasses.
- No algae or submerged aquatic weeds.



**Treatment:** I treated the shoreline grasses by airboat.

**Recommendations:** Thank you for cutting low hanging branches in the easement, I can now use the easement to launch my airboat.

### Lake N: Rated: 8

- Moderate grasses around perimeter.
- Minor bacopa.



**Treatment:** I launched the airboat and treated the grasses, including where the drains discharge into the pond.

**Recommendations:** Keep a lookout for gators.

### Lake V-2: Rated: 7

- Minor shoreline grasses.
- Spotty live chara and heavy dead chara.
- Moderate floating algae in the south cove.

**Treatment:** I launched the airboat and treated the algae, chara and grasses.

**Recommendations:** I plan to stock more grass carp this fall to better control the weeds.
