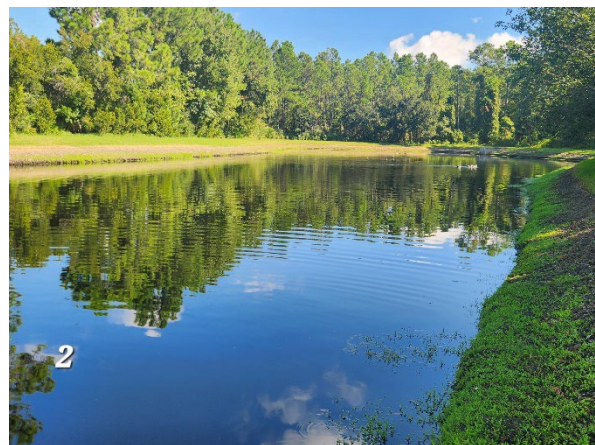

Copper sulfate, Cutrine

Lake 2: Rated: 6

- Water level is very low from the bleeddown pipe coming off after cleaning the fish barrier.
- Heavy bacopa patches around the perimeter.



Treatment: I replaced the bleeddown pipe so the water level should return to normal after the next rain. I also hand raked some of the bacopa. There is no need for a meeting now.

Recommendations: I plan to stock more grass carp this winter.

Lake SV2C: Rated: 6

- Patches of topped out bacopa along the shoreline.
- Minor torpedo grass.

Treatment: I launched the airboat and broke up some of the bacopa, hand raked some, and treated the torpedo grass. **Treating the bacopa would require irrigation restriction.**

Recommendations: I plan to stock more grass carp this winter.

Lake SV2A: Rated: 6

- Floating algae across 5% of pond surface.
- Water level is a little low.



Treatment: I launched the airboat and broke up the algae and then treated it.
Recommendations: I plan to stock more grass carp this winter.
