<u>Special Notes:</u> Many of the lakes are very low from lack of rain causing temporary issues such as algae blooms and discoloration. Once the typical rains start, the lakes will improve.

Lake Y-2: Rated: 8

- Lake level is very low.
- Minimal floating cyanobacteria, single celled blue-green algae and spotty back algae at NE cove.



<u>**Treatment:**</u> I hand raked the debris in the NE cove. <u>**Recommendations:**</u> Dig out NE cove with small machine.

Lake L: Rated: 10

- Water level is very low.
- No weeds.



<u>**Treatment</u>**: Inspection only <u>**Recommendations**</u>: I will monitor this lake closely.</u>

Lake SV2B: Rated: 8

- Spotty torpedo grass amongst the beneficial aquatic plants.
- Beneficial plants have covered the staff gauge.



<u>**Treatment:**</u> I treated the aquatic plants near the staff gauge and torpedo grass. <u>**Recommendation:**</u> None

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Lake ER-1: Rated: 7

• Moderate to heavy bacopa and red ludwigia, which are native beneficial submersed plants, but are too heavy and are topped out around the perimeter.



Treatment: I launched the airboat and treated the weeds listed above. **Recommendations:** None.
