<u>**Treatment:**</u> I hand raked the north cove and sprayed adjuvant to break up the surface tension of the floating cyanobacteria. **Recommendations:** None.

## Lake L: Rated: 9

- Water level is high.
- Spotty shoreline grasses.



<u>Treatment</u>: Inspection only. <u>Recommendations</u>: None.

## Lake ER-1: Rated: 7

- Spotty floating red ludwigia and bacopa.
- Minor alligatorweed along the edge.



<u>**Treatment:**</u> I hand raked a lot of floating red ludwigia, bacopa and alligatorweed. <u>**Recommendation:**</u> None.
