Weather Conditions: Partly cloudy, windy, cool today.

<u>Special Notes:</u> We have three lakes with outbreaks of cyanobacteria now, Y-2, I-1 and 11. These three will be treated with alum until they no longer have cyanobacteria. The windy conditions tend to knock down the floating cyanobacteria as it prefers stagnant conditions.

### Lake Y-2: Rated: 7

• Cyanobacteria is barely noticeable.



**Treatment:** Inspection only.

**Recommendations:** I plan to treat with alum on Monday.

## **Lake 11:** Rated: 7

- Fish kill occurred earlier in the week, today there were only three bluegill and one bass.
- Minor cyanobacteria today, it has dissipated somewhat.



<u>Treatment</u>: I treated cyanobacteria with Earthtec (labeled for cyanobacteria control). I also picked up the dead fish. The fish kill was most likely due to the cyanobacteria which has cyanotoxins which are toxic to fish.

**Recommendations:** I plan to treat with Alum on Monday.

#### **Lake I-1:** Rated: 7

- Floating Cyanobacteria has dissipated.
- Minor floating green algae on the north side that is dying from Monday's treatment.



**Treatment:** Inspection only.

**Recommendations:** I will treat with Alum on Monday.
